## HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP NOMINATION FORM

- A member/builder who has made a significant contribution to the game. (Requires AGM approval)
- A curler winning two Canadian Championships with at least one being a men's or women's title (sanctioned events only). Exceptions: 1) a Canadian and World Championship team in the men's or women's events in any given year. 2) a curler winning three Canadian Championships.
- A curler winning five (5) Ontario Provincial (OCA Sanctioned) championships with only one being from the Junior Men and Junior Women event.
