Summary of the Position:

Reporting to the Director of Ice Facilities, the successful applicant will be responsible to install and maintain the curling ice, 6 sheets, including spring removal, and ensure that all ice-making equipment is operated efficiently, safely, and effectively for the entire curling season.

Qualifications Required

Minimum Level 2 Ice Technician Certification
Ability to work with minimum direction
Working knowledge of ice plant control systems
Strong interpersonal and communication skills
Good planning and organizational skills,

Major Responsibilities

The Head Ice Technician is responsible for the day-to-day ice operations ensuring high quality playing conditions as well as establishing and maintaining a positive working relationship with the Ice Director, Board of Directors, Ice staff.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

Ice installation, ice painting, ring and signage installation, and removable hack installation
Schedule and implement maintenance floods, practice times, and draw changes when required
Daily equipment maintenance and log keeping
Recruitment, training, and scheduling of assistant ice staff
Minor facilities maintenance and repair as needed both on and off the ice
Removal of ice, and proper storage of rocks, signage, and equipment
